WHEREAS, access to library resources and information connections are very important to all Brown County residents for the purpose of business, education, recreation and leisure; and

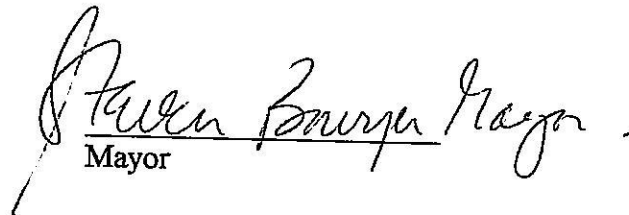
WHEREAS, the Brown County Public Library District was created in June, 1995 to provide library services to the residents of Brown County; and

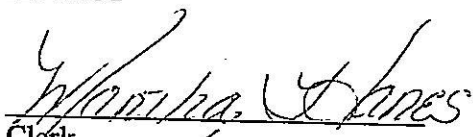
