Regular Village Council Meeting
May 9, 2005

Present: Mayor Wyndal Staggs, Harry Tolliver, Larry Talbott, Keith Staggs, Betty Kirkpatrick, Jack Shouse and Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle.
Also Present: Mike Salisbury, Jim Canter, Cecelia Potts and Wayne Boblitt.

Mayor Staggs called this regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes of the previous meeting, as well as the April, 2005 Bank Reconciliation, the Payment Register, Fund Status, Revenue Status and the Appropriation Status Reports. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, and Mr. Staggs seconded it. The motion carried, all members voting yes. The Bank Reconciliation and the financial reports were read and approved.

The Council discussed a possible Police Levy.

Ms Potts informed the Council that we can pay the Police Officers from

the Street Fund if they direct traffic while our maintenance people are painting lines.

Mayor Staggs met with Mark Wilcox who is a Boy Scout Leader. His troop wants to clean up Hannah Park, paint benches, plant flowers, etc. Mr. Tolliver made a motion to have them do so, and Mr. Staggs seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

The Council agreed to start the Village Wide Yard sales on Thursday. The Council asked Ms. Potts about the yard sale signs that people from outside town leave up after the sale. She told the Council to remove them.

As of now, we will no longer chip limbs from the storm. We will go back to chipping for \$50.00 only when requested.

Mr. Staggs made a motion to give the Mayor the ability to have the streets cleaned if it costs less than \$450.00. Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to adjourn. Mr. Staggs seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.
