Village Council Meeting
May 18, 2020

The Council of the Village of Hamersville met in regular session at the Village Municipal Building on Monday, May 18, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. with all members present except Betty Kirkpatrick and Joe Packer.

Also, present were: Guy Sutton, David Grimes, Brandon Copley, Shelly Spencer and Jessie Spencer.

Mayor Hill called the regular meeting to order and then led the everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Public Participation

Ms. Shelly Spencer requested permission from Council to hold a drive-by birthday party for her daughter through town on May 30, 2020 at 2:00 p.m. A brief discussion ensued with general consensus of Council to permit the event.

Old Business

Motion by: Ms. Miller, Seconded by: Mr. Wilson, to approve the minutes of the March 16, 2020.
Motion passed unanimously.

Ms. Miller inquired if actions were being taken to address a drainage issue (water crossing the sidewalk) on the main street through the Village. A discussion ensued regarding the matter with possible options for re-routing the water to improve proper drainage.

Administrator's Report

Mr. Sutton reported on the following:

- Maintenance worker has returned to work after absence for a medical condition.
- New Village K-9 to begin training
- Donation of PPE has been received from Axon
- Status of sewer plant loan and possibility of building a new plant
- Mayor's Court Clerk has resigned. A replacement will need to be hired.
- Account has been set-up with LESO (organization that provides assistance to local police departments).

A discussion ensued regarding the Village's current sewer plant and the possibility of building a new plant.

Also discussed was the hiring of a replacement for the mayor's court clerk which included qualifications and salary as well as possibly having the employee be crossed trained as a backup for the Village's utility clerk.

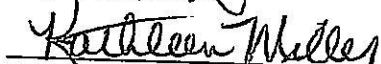

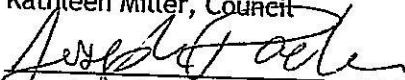
There being no further business, Ms. Miller made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Mr. Wilson, The motion passed unanimously.



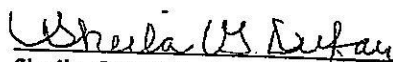

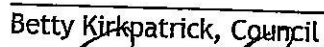
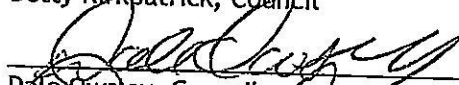
