Regular Village Council Meeting
 September 13, 2010

Present: Mayor Larry Talbott, Harry Tolliver, Wyndal Staggs, Betty Kirkpatrick, Michele Watson, Keith Staggs, Ragan Ernst and Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle.

Mayor Talbott called this regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes of the previous meeting to the Council, as well as the Warrant Register, Fund Status, Revenue Status and Appropriation Status reports, and the August, 2010 Bank Reconciliation. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to accept the minutes, and Ms. Ernst seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes. All other reports and the Bank Reconciliation were read and approved.

Mayor Talbott recognized Wayne Johnson, who is the Pastor of God's Mission on Walnut and Sisterville. He came to discuss tearing down some buildings that were donated to them. He also discussed moving out a trailer on Richey and replacing it with a nicer one. The council told them they could replace the trailer with a better one, but the Street Committee wanted to see it first. He thanked Council.

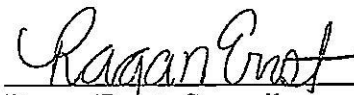
Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to put up notices if there are any more planned power outages, and Ms. Ernst seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

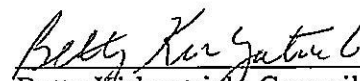
The State has put passing zones inside the Village on both St. Rt. 125 and St. Rt. 774. Chief Canter will call them.

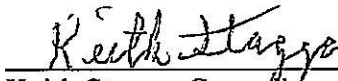
Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to adjourn, and Ms. Watson seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

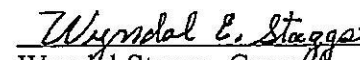
