Regular Village Council Meeting
 November 11, 2013

Mayor Kirkpatrick thanked Ms. Ernst for taking care of things on Halloween.

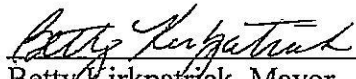
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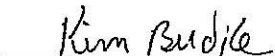

Ms. Ernst made a motion to adjourn. Mr. Kirby seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

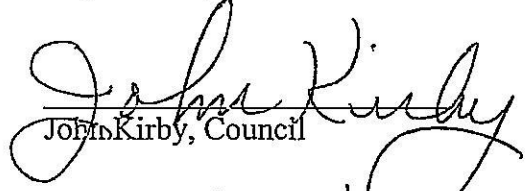
