Regular Village Council Meeting
September 11, 2000

Present: Mayor Duane C. Neu, Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle, and the following members of the Village Council: Donnie Sowers, Bill Dean, Scott Malicote, Wyndal Staggs, Kevin Ogle and Joyce Craig.

Also Present: Village Solicitor Cecelia Potts, Eunice Ott, and the following Political Candidates asking for Council's support: Tom Niehaus-State Representative, Gary Himes-County Recorder, Bill Neal-County Commissioner, Kenneth Martin-County Sheriff, Dwayne Wenninger-County Sheriff, Perry Ogden-County Commissioner, Jim Beasley-County Engineer, Dale Reynolds-County Commissioner, Jim Ferguson-County Commissioner.

The Board of Public Affairs members were also here to discuss the electric contract with CG&E, along with Jack Sandman and Linda Jeanmougin of CG&E.

Mayor Neu called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

After the political candidates addressed the Council, Mayor Neu recognized Mr. Sharp of the Board of Public Affairs to present the contract. The contract was read and discussed. Mr. Dean moved to accept the contract, and Mr. Sowers seconded the motion. The motion carried, all voting yes.

Mr. Sowers moved to accept the minutes of the previous meeting as presented by the Clerk Treasurer. Mr. Malicote seconded the motion. The motion carried, all voting yes.

Mayor Neu recognized Ms. Potts. She brought the contract for the Magistrate for Mayor's Court. It is the same as last year, \$6000.00 for the year, \$500.00 per month. The Council needs to discuss a new two to three mil levy to support our police department. Mr. Dean moved to accept the contract, and Mr. Sowers seconded the motion. The motion carried, all members voting yes. The Council needs to have a Budget Committee meeting. The Clerk Treasurer will check with the County Auditor for our millage and other pertinent information.

The Council Members were informed of the Post Audit Conference with the State Auditors on September 20.

Mayor Neu then recognized Police Chief Jim Canter. He informed the Council that both cruisers are down. The Council told him to go ahead and have them fixed. He has had calls from people looking for positions with our Department, but they are no longer interested after finding out what the jobs pay. We are short-handed now.
