Regular Village Council Meeting
January 14, 2002

Mr. Green cleaned out the ditches on Adkins Place, but they need done again already. We also have others in town that are clogged up. Joyce Barger has complained about the water under her house from the lack of drainage. The Street Committee will look into it.

Chief Canter informed the Council that the School bus on Adkins has been taken care of. There was an accident at the grocery store in town a week or so ago. Chief Canter asked the Council to look over the fine schedule to see if they want to raise any of the fines. They agreed to leave them as-is for now. The blue car is not acting right. It needs a lot of work. The engine is about ready to go out.

Mr. Green went to Barnes training. He picked up a PSU application, and brought a list of tools he needs. Mr. Staggs made a motion to approve the vacation time recommended for Mr. Green by the Board of Public Affairs, and Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion. The motion carried, all voting yes.

Ms. Craig made a motion to adopt the temporary budget of \$1,290,862.97. Mr. Staggs seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all voting yes.

Mr. Staggs made a motion to adjourn, and Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion. The motion carried, all voting yes.
