Regular Village Council Meeting
May 13, 2002

Present: Mayor Duane C. Neu, Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle, and the following members of the Village Council: Wyndal Staggs, Donnie Sowers, Diana Shuemake, Betty Kirkpatrick and Larry Talbott. Also Present: Police Chief Jim Canter, Pat Scott, Phil Patton, Russ Ernst, Kenny Green, Robert & Teresa Helton, Jesse Green, Cecelia Potts, and Shane Green.

Mayor Neu called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then asked Mr. Staggs to lead the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the reports which included the Warrant Register, Fund Status, Revenue Account Status and Expenditure Account Status.

Mayor Neu recognized Mr. Ernst, who lives on the corner of Wayne and Adkins Place. He came to complain about the drainage problem on those two streets. Two of the residents on the north end of Adkins Place have filled in their drainage ditches. The school's catch basin is higher than the run-off. This is causing a major backup of water there. He presented pictures of the area. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to have Ronnie Blair take care of it. Mr. Talbott seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all voting yes. The Clerk Treasurer will contact Mr. Blair.

Mayor Neu recognized Mr. & Mrs. Helton. Mr. Helton told the Council they had lived in the Village for 25 years. He said that in the beginning, there was 24 hour Police protection. He wants to know what has changed. Last week, he had a man threaten him in his own driveway. The Deputy Sheriff got there before our Police Officer did. He wanted to know if we can build firehouses and schools, why can't we have one 24 hour Police Officer. He is moving at the end of the school year, and is worried about his 67 year old mother living alone. He also complained about our trucks using their private road (Dooley). He asked Council to take over half of the upkeep on the road. Council told him it had to be up to specs before we can accept it.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes from the previous meeting. Mr. Sowers made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all voting

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yes.

Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to pay all bills as presented, and Mr. Talbott seconded the motion. The motion carried, all members voting yes.

Our truck is fixed. Mr. Green needs to pick it up. The sewer discharge line is broken at John Schneider's house on Main Street. It is leaking badly. We will have Ronnie Blair fix it as soon as possible.

Ms. Scott informed the Board that her sewer is out and has been for seven weeks. She told Mr. Green to fix it now. He told her it will make a mess because of the water. We still have two other pumps out at this time, Malicotte's and Napier's. There have been 30 pumps

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break down this year. Ms. Potts will check on the bonds from the original work.

Mr. Talbott made a motion to raise the appropriation for the Contract Services in the Sewer Operating Fund by \$2,000.00, and reducing the Equipment appropriation by that amount. Mr. Staggs seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all voting yes.

Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to have Mr. Green purchase a new pressure washer to clean the streets. Mr. Staggs seconded the motion. The motion carried, all voting yes. There is a hole behind the storm drain across from the grocery store. We need to fill it in.

Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to send the Clerk Treasurer to the UAN Payroll class in Columbus in July (1 week). Ms. Shuemake seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all voting yes.

Chief Canter talked to our magistrate about the complaints signed by residents about noise. The residents complained that these people are running the streets all night long. Officer Patton told Council to give them more hours to work.

Ms. Shuemake will pick up flags for the town. She took the information into the County for the CDBG Grant Application. Mr. Staggs will call Bob Eubanks about fixing Police building.

Mr. Sowers left due to his wife's illness.

Jesse Green and Shane Green both came to apply for the Street Department position. After considering both applications, Mr. Talbott made a motion to hire Jesse Green for 50 hours per month at \$8.00 per hour. Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all remaining members voting yes.

Ms. Kirkpatrick asked the Clerk Treasurer to thank the Clark Township Trustees for their handling of the Township Cleanup. Everyone is happy with the street work.

Mr. Staggs made a motion to adjourn, and Ms. Shuemake seconded the motion. The motion carried, all voting yes.
