

ORDINANCE # 1976-3

ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE EMERGENCY REPAIRS TO
THE WATER TANK OF THE VILLAGE OF HAMERSVILLE
AND OBTAINING FORMAL BIDDING AND ADVERTISING
FOR CONTRACT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of
Hamersville, more than two-thirds (2/3) of their members
concurring:

SECTION I. It appearing that the Village of Hamersville has
been notified by regulatory agencies of the State of Ohio that
the water pressure of the Village is below tolerable limits and
that because of the low pressure the Village may be unable to
provide satisfactory protection to the structures situated in the
Village; and further appearing that in order to alleviate said
low pressure and to make such other repairs to the tank as may
be necessary for the protection of the tank, and to insure
sufficient pressure in the water system, it is necessary to make
immediate repairs to the water tank.

SECTION II. It is further ordained that the circumstances
set forth in Section I and the availability of the contractors
to do the necessary repairs constitutes a real and present
emergency arising in connection with the maintenance of the water
system and as such, obviate the necessity for formal bidding and
advertising for the contract to repair said water tank pursuant
to the provisions of Section 735.051 O.R.C.

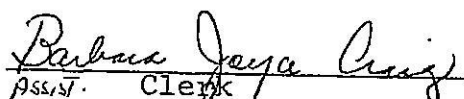
SECTION III. It is further ordained that the Board of
Public Affairs of the Village of Hamersville enter into a
contract for the necessary repairs to the water tank of the
Village, and the sum of Five Thousand Five Hundred Dollars
(\$5,500.00) is hereby appropriated from the water fund of
Hamersville in order to pay for these repairs.

SECTION IV. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency ordinance necessary for the health, safety and welfare
of the inhabitants of the Village of Hamersville, Ohio, and more
particularly in order to provide a better operation of the Village
water system and shall be in immediate effect upon its passage.
