Regular Village Council Meeting
August 9, 2004

Present: Mayor Wyndal Staggs, Harry Tolliver, Keith Staggs, Betty Kirkpatrick, Larry Talbott and Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle.
Also Present: Cecelia Potts, Mike Salisbury, Police Chief Jim Canter, Kenny Green, Jared Riley and Wayne Boblitt.

Mayor Staggs called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes of the previous meeting, as well as the Fund Status report, Payment Register, Revenue Status report, Appropriation Status report and the July, 2004 Bank Reconciliation. The Council read and approved all reports and the Bank Reconciliation. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, and Mr. Talbott seconded it. The motion carried, all members voting yes.

Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to pay all bills as presented. Mr. Tolliver seconded the motion, and it carried, all members voting yes.

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Mayor Staggs informed the Council that a resident has asked for the old 12" culvert that we removed from Adkins Place. Council decided to keep it because we can use it again.

The water running out of the school is flooding Russ Ernst's house. The Council agreed to buy one 18" culvert, have Mr. Ernst buy one, and we will install them both.

Mr. Tolliver made a motion to put the snowblade, salt spreader and gas tank up for bids. Mr. Staggs seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

We have a culvert on Wooster that has railroad ties on top of it. The Street Committee will look into it and bring back a recommendation at the next meeting.

We had a resident ask for permission to burn. Mayor Staggs refused permission because of our Ordinance banning it. This resident also asked us to paint in front of his driveway. Mayor Staggs told the resident no.

Ms. Potts informed the Council to check with the Treasurer's office to see where the tax bill goes in order to send a mowing notice for some property whose owner is unknown. If the notice goes unclaimed, we can mow it and put it on the property taxes.

Mr. Tolliver made a motion to waive reading an Ordinance three times. Mr. Staggs seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes. Mr. Tolliver made a motion to make Wooster one-way from Park East to Fite Avenue. Mr. Talbott seconded the motion, and it carried, all members voting yes.

Ms. Kirkpatrick received compliments on the park this week.

The Council recognized the accomplishments of two Hamersville Knothole Baseball teams, the Hustlers and the Reds. Both of these teams won their district tournaments.

Mike is going to clean the dirt and grass from the edges of the streets and put it in the street for the sweepers.

We have had quite a few people who are not paying their traffic fines. Ms. Potts suggested setting time "suspended" and dating it for payments. If the fines are not paid, then we can serve them with bench warrants.

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Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to adjourn, and Mr. Staggs seconded the motion. The motion carried, all members voting yes.
