Regular Village Council Meeting
June 10, 2002

Present: Mayor Duane C. Neu, Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle, and the following members of the Village Council: Donnie Sowers, Betty Kirkpatrick, Larry Talbott and Wyndal Staggs.
Also Present: Hollee Chadwick, Jake Eskew, Pat Scott, Jim Canter, Phil Patton and Cecelia Potts.

Mayor Neu called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then asked Mr. Talbott to lead the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Neu then recognized Frenk Leone of Environmental Engineering. He updated the Council on the sewer project. The new pumps will be here tomorrow, and they plan to have them in and started up at 1:30 p.m. on Wednesday. If Allied is available, they will be here, too. The contractor plans to be finished by the 20th of this month. Mr. Leone presented a partial payment request of \$73,826.00 from Ameritcon, and asked for Council's approval. Mr. Staggs made a motion to approve the payment, and Mr. Talbott seconded the motion. The motion carried, all members voting yes. Mr. Leone then presented a change order from Ameritcon, which will save the Village \$3,000.00. Mr. Staggs made a motion to approve the change order, and Mr. Talbott seconded the motion. The motion carried, all members voting yes. Mr. Leone discussed the sewer's odor control problem with Council. As our flow goes into Mt. Orab's equalization basin, it falls about 16'. He suggested putting in a drop pipe. Our current contractor would charge \$1,888.82 to do so. Mr. Leone said we could then reduce our bioxide use and go from there. If this does not work, we may need to put in a small dosing station further along the line. Ms. Potts will discuss the drop pipe with Mt. Orab. We could also use Hydrogen Peroxide, but we would have to put the dosing station much closer to Mt. Orab. Mr. Leone agreed to have his company check on the individual pumps that keep going out. He informed the Council that the hydraulics may not be right, since the pumps are not the ones originally spec'd for the system. Ms. Scott also asked Mr. Leone to check on how regular maintenance would affect the pumps. He will bring his report back when it is finished. In the interim, he told the Council to get as many risers on as we can.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes of the previous meeting. Mr. Staggs made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Mr. Talbott seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all members

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voting yes. Also presented were the Warrant Register, Fund Status, Expenditure Account Status and Revenue Account Status.

Mr. Sowers made a motion to pay all bills as presented. Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all members voting yes.

Mayor Neu then read a letter of resignation from Council member Joyce Craig, stating that she has no time to devote to the Council. Mr. Talbott made a motion to accept the resignation and Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion. The motion carried, all members voting yes.

Ms. Potts checked on using the Computer Fund money to purchase the Police Cruiser. According to O.R.C. 5705.15 & .16, we would have to petition the court. Mr. Talbott made a motion to have Ms. Potts do so, and have the money placed in the General Fund. Mr. Sowers seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all members voting yes.

Mr. Staggs told the Police Officers present to check on pricing for Kevlar vests. Ms. Kirkpatrick paid \$555.00 for hers.

Mr. Staggs brought up the fact that the new street department employee has not been mowing. Mr. Staggs then made a motion to have all Council employees fill out daily worksheets (excluding the Police). Mr. Sowers seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all members

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voting yes.

Chief Canter contacted the school about the high grass there. They told him the contractor needs to come back to fix it. Chief Canter asked the Street Committee to look at the bush at Wooster and Sisterville. It needs cut. Also at Walnut & Orchard there are bushes that are blocking view of oncoming traffic. There is a big hole on Travis that needs to be filled in. The Police has had 2 cases transferred to County Court. Cecelia needs copies of the files. Suzanne will send them to her right away. Officer Patton wants to be paid every 2 weeks instead of one a month. Mr. Staggs informed him that it has never been done. The Council told him no.

Mr. Staggs has a proposal for more street work. It will have to wait until we have more money in the street fund. The Council will have a special meeting on June 17, 2002 after the Board of Public Affairs meeting. The Clerk Treasurer will be sure Kenny & Jesse Green are here.

Mr. Staggs made a motion to adjourn. Mr. Talbott seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all members voting yes.
