

ORDINANCE #2011-_____

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE #1997-17 GOVERNING THE
USE OF THE VILLAGE SANITARY SEWERS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF
HAMERSVILLE AND PASSED AS AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio has an Ordinance governing the use of the Village Sanitary Sewers within the Village of Hamersville, and

WHEREAS, the existing Ordinance does not address a tap situation when there is no use on the existing tap, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Hamersville, Ohio feels it is necessary to address the unused taps within the Village of Hamersville

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hamersville, State of Ohio, that the Ordinance governing the use of the Village Sanitary Sewer shall be amended as follows:

Section 1: Section 4: SEWER CONNECTIONS OR TAPS shall be amended to add the provision regarding unused taps as follows:

E. Any unused tap as a result of the user's residence or building being removed from the real estate may be retired and removed upon the application of the property owner. As a result of the retirement and removal of said tap, the property owner would not pay a minimum fee for sewer use. The tap may be reinstated by a payment of \$2,000.00 and an application signed by the property owner to reinstate said tap.

Section 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the reason that the public health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Hamersville, Ohio, require the immediate issuance of said ordinance and the same shall take effect and be in full force

immediately upon its adoption.
