Regular Village Council Meeting
 July 11, 2016

Present: Mayor Betty Kirkpatrick, Kim Budke, Kathleen Miller, Dale Owsley, Wayne Hill and Fiscal Officer Tammie Ogle.

Also present: Chief Guy Sutton, Jack Jones, Mrs. Jones, Jason LaRue and Nick from Choice One.

Mayor Kirkpatrick called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Fiscal Officer presented the minutes of the previous meeting to the Council, as well as the Warrant Register, Fund Status, Revenue Status and Appropriation Status Reports, and the June, 2016 Bank Reconciliation. Ms. Budke made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, and Ms. Miller seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

Mayor Kirkpatrick recognized Nick from Choice One, who came to discuss his company, and how they can help us to receive financing for sidewalks. They are an engineering firm who designs roads, sidewalks, etc. They offer a free estimate for the cost, and help write grant applications, at no cost. The Council agreed to have Choice One do an estimate for the Village. The deadline for OPWC funding is October 7.

Chief Sutton will tell Harry Tolliver to stop dumping his yard trash on the vacant lot on Bank Street.

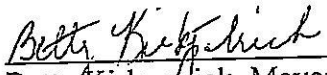
Mr. Hill wants to do a festival or parade to raise money to benefit local children.

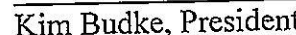
Mr. Owsley asked about our emergency preparedness. Chief Sutton explained our plan.

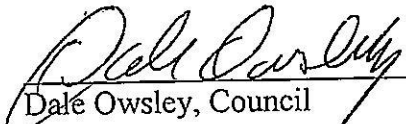
Mr. Hill made a motion to adjourn, and Ms. Miller seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

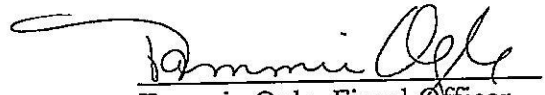
