ORDINANCE NO. 234

DATE OF ENACTMENT 4-6-67

An emergency ordinance enacted by the ~~City~~ ^{Village} of Homeraville,
~~town~~ County, Ohio, in the matter of the hereinafter described improvement,
under the supervision of the Director of Highways.

WHEREAS, the Director of Highways is considering improving a portion of the public highway
which is described as follows:

**By cleaning and painting existing guard rail on S.R. 125 (Main St.),
Length of Rail - 84 ft., 2 runs**

Ohio: NOW THEREFORE, Be it ordained by the Council of the ~~City~~ ^{Village} of Homeraville,

SECTION I (Consent)

That it is declared to be in the public interest that the consent of said Village be and such
consent is hereby given to the Director of Highways to construct the above described improvement, in
accordance with plans, specifications and estimates as approved by the Director.

SECTION II (Cooperation)

That said Village hereby proposes to cooperate with the State of Ohio, in the cost of the above
described improvement as follows:

SECTION III (Authority to Sign)

That the *[Signature]* ~~Mayor~~ ^{Contractual Officer} of said Village, is hereby authorized to enter
into maintenance and parking agreements and special contractual obligations.

SECTION VIII (Emergency Clause)

This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure by reason of the need for expediting highway improvements to promote highway safety, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
