

ORDINANCE NO. 248

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR PERMIT TO LAY SIX-INCH
WATER MAIN AND FOR RIGHT OF INGRESS AND EGRESS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hamersville,
Brown County, Ohio, three-fourths or more of all members
elected thereto concurring as follows:

SECTION I.

That Edna Pride be authorized to install
at her expense a six-inch water main with
a cut off valve near the intersection of
State Route #125 in an alley running north
from State Route #125 to her property and
being located between the property of Joe
Boling and Floyd Pitzer, said water main to
be installed at not less than three and one-
half (3-1/2) feet in depth and within two(2)
feet of the boundary of said alley.

SECTION II.

That Edna Pride be and hereby is authorized
to use said alley for ingress and egress
from State Route #125 to her property.

SECTION III.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency ordinance necessary for the public
health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants
of the Village of Hamersville and it is
necessary that it shall be in immediate
effect upon its passage.
