

COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HAMERSVILLE, OHIO

RESOLUTION NO. 1980-3

REQUIRING THAT, IN CONNECTION WITH THE FY-1980 PROGRAM, TO THE GREATEST EXTENT FEASIBLE OPPORTUNITIES FOR TRAINING AND EMPLOYMENT BE GIVEN TO LOWER INCOME RESIDENTS OF THE PROJECT AREA AND CONTRACTS FOR WORK IN CONNECTION THEREWITH BE AWARDED TO ELIGIBLE BUSINESS CONCERNS LOCATED IN, OR OWNED IN SUBSTANTIAL PART BY PERSONS RESIDING IN AREA OF THE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, in submitting an application for assistance in Fiscal Year 1980 under the Community Development Block Grant Program, the Village of Hamersville has provided assurances and has certified that it will comply with Section 3 of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1968, as amended, requiring that to the greatest possible extent feasible opportunities for training and employment be given to lower income residents of the project area and contracts in connection with the project be awarded to eligible business concerns which are located in, or owned in substantial part by persons residing in the area of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Hamersville, three-fourths (3/4) or more of all the members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION I. That all bidders submitting proposals for work in connection with the Fiscal Year 1980 Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Project of the Village of Hamersville, Ohio, are required to submit with their bids an Affirmative Action Program for utilizing project area residents and businesses.

SECTION II. That all contracts and subcontracts shall contain the Section 3 clause which shall be distributed to any prospective bidder by the Village of Hamersville.
