

COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HAMERSVILLE, OHIO
RESOLUTION NO. 1979-1

ADOPTING A CITIZEN PARTICIPATION PLAN WHICH WILL PROVIDE NECESSARY CITIZEN PARTICIPATION FOR THE VILLAGE'S COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM AND FOR ANY OTHER ISSUES NECESSITATING CITIZEN PARTICIPATION; AND AUTHORIZING THE SELECTION OF A CITIZENS' ADVISORY COMMITTEE AS DEFINED IN THE CITIZEN PARTICIPATION PLAN.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Hamersville, three-fourths (3/4) of all the members thereto concurring:

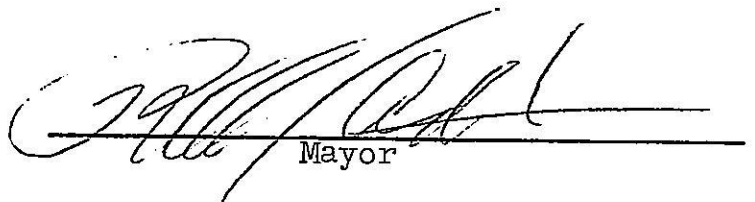
SECTION I. That the Village of Hamersville needs a mechanism by which citizens can voice their concerns and in turn be informed of actions taken by the Village to implement Community Development. Public hearings have been advertised and held so that citizens have participated in the development of a "Citizen Participation Plan" which will provide the said mechanism. The Council of the Village of Hamersville has reviewed and approved this plan.

SECTION II. That the Mayor, Roger Adkins, be and hereby is authorized and directed to appoint members to the "Citizens' Advisory Committee" as defined in the Citizen Participation Plan.

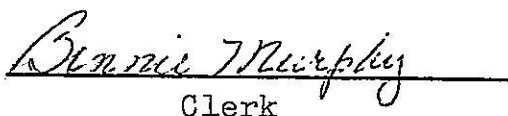
SECTION III. That the Council of the Village of Hamersville directs that public notice be made, notifying all residents of this plan and its implementation; and placing it on display for public examination at the Community Building of the Village of Hamersville.

Therefore it is resolved that the "Citizen Participation Plan" is adopted as a guide and mechanism for Hamersville to implement citizen participation.
