

ORDINANCE NO. 1983.5

AN ORDINANCE IMPLEMENTING A WORK PROGRAM IN LIEU OF
PAYMENT OF A MONETARY FINE FOR PERSONS CONVICTED IN
THE VILLAGE OF HAMERSVILLE MAYOR'S COURT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hamersville,
Brown County, Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) or more of all members
thereof concurring as follows:

SECTION I. That the Mayor of the Village of Hamersville be
and hereby is authorized to permit persons convicted of violating
the ordinances of the Village of Hamersville in the Mayor's Court
of the Village of Hamersville, to perform public service work
in lieu of payment of a monetary fine to the Village of Hamersville.

SECTION II. That persons who are permitted to perform public
service work in lieu of payment of a monetary fine shall receive
a credit against his/her fine at the rate of the lowest prevailing
wage paid by the Village of Hamersville, Ohio for manual labor.

SECTION III. That no person shall be permitted to enter
into the work program established by this ordinance unless he or
she voluntarily requests permission to do so.

SECTION IV. That the status of any person permitted to
enter into the work program established by this ordinance shall
be that of an independant contractor and no person permitted to
participate in said work program shall be entitled to any benefits
and/or coverage with respect to PERS and Worker's Compensation.

SECTION V. That no person may be permitted to perform
public service work in lieu of payment of court costs.

SECTION VI. That nothing contained herein shall be deemed
to require the Mayor of the Village of Hamersville to permit
any person to perform public service work in lieu of payment of
a monetary fine and the decision as to whether any person shall be
so permitted shall rest entirely within the decretion of the
Mayor.

SECTION VII. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency ordinance necessary for the health, safety and

welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio and more particularly to enable the Village of Hamersville Mayor's Court to effectively function in a depressed economy and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
