Regular Village Council Meeting
May 10, 2004

Present: Mayor Wyndal Staggs, Harry Tolliver, Betty Kirkpatrick, Eric Johnson, Kevin Ogle, Larry Talbott and Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle.
Also Present: Keith Staggs, Wayne Boblitt, Police Chief Jim Canter and Cecelia Potts.

Mayor Staggs called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the Payment Register, Fund Status report, Appropriation and Revenue Status reports, Bank Reconciliation for April 2004, and the minutes of the previous meeting. The Council approved the Bank Reconciliation, and Mr. Ogle made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

Mayor Staggs then recognized Keith Staggs, who came to express his interest in the vacant seat on the Council. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to appoint him to the seat, and Mr. Tolliver seconded the motion. The motion carried, all voting yes. Mayor Staggs then swore Mr. Staggs in, and he took his seat at the table.

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Mr. Ogle made a motion to pay all bills as presented, and Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion. The motion carried, all members voting yes.

Mr. Ogle made a motion to suspend the rules for reading an ordinance three times. Mr. Talbott seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2004-04, regulating yard sales, and Mr. Johnson seconded the motion. The motion carried, all members voting yes. The Council then agreed to hold a Village wide yard sale on the first weekend in August, Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

Mayor Staggs has taken care of the problem at 261 West Main. The ditch has not been cleaned out yet because it is still too wet.

Mayor Staggs bought 20 new flags, and he and Mr. Tolliver put them up this past week. Mr. Talbott thanked the Mayor for all the hard work he has done.

Contract Sweepers has submitted a quote for sweeping the streets once for \$395. Mr. Talbott made a motion to have them do it, and Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded it. The motion carried, all members voting yes.

Mayor Staggs recognized Chief Canter, who informed the Council that one of our officers has been going to court for the B & E's, and has missed time at his full-time job. Council agreed to have him work eight hours on the days he goes to court. Mayor Staggs informed Council that Chief Canter and Patrolman Graham have done an outstanding job on the B & E's.

Mr. Ogle made a motion to create the position of helper for Mr. Shaffer at \$11.50 per hour. Mr. Tolliver seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

Mr. Ogle made a motion to adjourn. Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

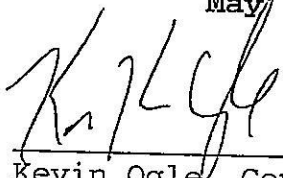

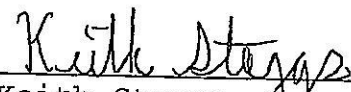
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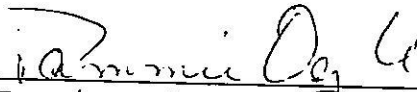
