Regular Village Council Meeting
June 11, 2003

Present: Mayor Wyndal Staggs, Betty Kirkpatrick, Harry Tolliver, Larry Talbott, Kevin Ogle and Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle.

Also Present: Marsha Mundy, Larry Weatherspoon, Wayne Boblitt, Kenny Green, Chief Jim Canter, Roger Stickers and Lisa Pack.

Mr. Staggs called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Staggs then read Diana Shuemake's resignation from the Village Council. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to accept the resignation, and Mr. Talbott seconded the motion. The motion carried with all members voting yes.

Mr. Staggs recognized Larry Weatherspoon, who came to ask about dedicating Dooley Lane. Mr. Staggs informed him that the road has to be up to code first. He also inquired about the drainage from North Avenue on to Dooley. The culvert is smashed and is overflowing to the foundation of the houses, The Mayor and Street Committee will look at it.

Mr. Staggs then recognized Roger Stickers, who is representing Stonehouse Building Products. Their insurance carrier is concerned that the nearest fire hydrant is at the end of the road. Mr. Ogle told Council that the line is an old cast iron one that needs replaced. This would be a good time to do both. The Mayor will bring it before the BPA.

Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to pay all bills as presented, and Mr. Tolliver seconded the motion. The motion carried, all voting yes.

Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to have Brown County Asphalt pave Sisterville and Adkins Place, and fix the cracks on Bank Street, for a combined cost of \$4783.60. Mr. Tolliver seconded the motion, and it carried, with all members voting yes. The Council decided to wait before dealing with Wayne and Travis due to some culvert work.

Mr. Talbott made a motion to have Ronnie Blair fix the culvert on Wayne Avenue, and Mr. Ogle seconded the motion. The motion carried, all members voting yes.

Mr. Staggs brought an employment application from Charles Canter, Jr. Mr. Ogle made a motion to hire Mr. Canter for 80 hours per month at \$8.50 per hour to do street work. Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

Mr. Staggs thanked everyone for their work on the offices, naming Chief Canter in particular. Everything looks very nice.

The interest rate on our 28 day CD has dropped to below 1%. The Clerk Treasurer brought this to the attention of the Council, asking for their input on how to handle it. Mr. Ogle made a motion to leave it where it is. Mr. Talbott seconded the motion, and it carried, with all members voting yes.

Mr. Talbott thanked the Clerk Treasurer for her professionalism. Mr. Staggs agreed.

The Center for Missing and Exploited Children has sent the Police Department a computer. They pay the first year of internet fees, and everything else is provided free of charge, including a printer and scanner. Mr. Staggs asked Council where they want it set up. Council

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agreed to put it in the Mayor's office, and he will check it regularly. Mr. Staggs will also double check that there are no hidden charges.

The flags are getting tattered again. Mr. Staggs will check on better ones with Buckeye Flag. Jared Cornet offered to buy 17 more brackets for the flags. Mr. Staggs wants to ask him to buy new flags instead. Mr. Ogle made a motion to allow the Mayor to purchase flags if he can find some we can afford, and Mr. Talbott seconded the motion. The motion carried, all members voting yes.

Mr. Staggs will meet with Bruce Brandstetter Monday to discuss a possible grant for sidewalks.

Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to adopt the 2003 Ohio Basic Code. Mr. Ogle seconded the motion, and it carried with all members voting yes.

Chief Canter thanked the Clerk Treasurer for helping him get the Automobile notice letters ready. There were 30 of them. The Police Department handed them all out. The Police Department needs patches. The Clerk Treasurer will order them.

Mr. Ogle made a motion to go into Executive Session. Mr. Talbott seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes. Mr. Ogle made a motion to come out of Executive Session, and Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

Mr. Talbott made a motion to raise the base sewer rates \$5.00 per month, starting with the next bills. Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes. Mr. Talbott made a motion to give Mr. Green 40 hours maximum per week at \$11.00 per hour, with a \$.50 per hour raise possible every 6 months, up to \$12.00. Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

Mr. Talbott made a motion that all employees will now be required to maintain a clean and healthy work environment as follows:

Maintenance Dept's.-Keep shops cleaned and vehicles vacuumed.

Police Dept.-Keep vehicles cleaned and vacuumed and garage and Mayor's Court clean and vacuumed.

Billing Clerk-Keep front office vacuumed (at least once per week), bathroom cleaned, windows cleaned and garbage can emptied.

Clerk and Mayor-Keep their office cleaned and vacuumed, and garbage cans emptied.

Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion, and it carried, all members voting yes.

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Mr. Ogle made a motion to adjourn. Mr. Talbott seconded the motion, and it carried, all members voting yes.
