Regular Village Council Meeting
July 8, 2013

Present: Mayor Betty Kirkpatrick, Michele Watson, Kathleen Miller, Ragan Ernst, John Kirby and Fiscal Officer Tammie Ogle.

Also present: Chief Canter, Jared Riley, Skip Bollinger, Al Rhoten, Kim Budke, Kent Hacker, Michele Rueve, Vicky Coburn and David Grimes.

Mayor Kirkpatrick called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance. Before this meeting, Mayor Kirkpatrick appointed Ms. Budke to Council, and swore her in.

The Fiscal Officer presented the minutes of the previous meeting to the Council, as well as the Warrant Register, Fund Status, Revenue Status and Appropriation Status Reports, and the June, 2013 Bank Reconciliation. Mr. Kirby made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, and Ms. Miller seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

Mayor Kirkpatrick recognized Vicky Coburn, who came to discuss a warrant fee and the MARCS radios, which we will have to start paying a fee of \$20.00 each per month in January, 2014.

Mayor Kirkpatrick recognized Mr. Rhoten, who lives on Sisterville Road. The Council discussed the ORC Nuisance Ordinance.

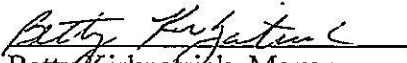
July 8, 2013, cont'd.

Ms. Ernst made a motion to adjourn, and Mr. Kirby seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

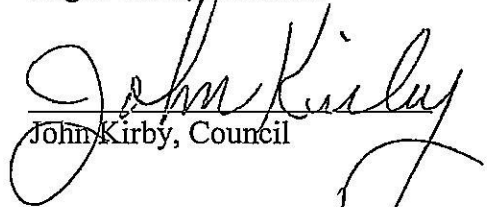
