Regular Village Council Meeting
April 14, 2003

Present: Mayor Wyndal Staggs, Kevin Ogle, Larry Talbott, Betty Kirkpatrick, Diana Shuemade, Crystal Haas and Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle.

Neu, Dennis Schneider, LG Shaffer, Carolyn and Gary Donner, Marsha Mundy, Kenny Green, Police Chief Jim Canter, Jeff Thompson, Ben Graham, Roger Adkins, Colby Saylor, Ken Ogle, Jared Riley, Kay Elliott, Suzanne Elliott-Madden, Ray Canter, Edith Neu, Ken, Tina and Ben Ballein.

Mr. Staggs called this meeting to order and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes of the previous meeting. Mr. Ogle made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, and Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion. The motion carried, all members voting yes.

Mr. Staggs recognized Mr. Thompson, who came to get acquainted with the Council and to ask about the regulations concerning subdividing property. He plans to build some houses on Fite Avenue.

Mr. Ogle made a motion to pay all bills as presented. Ms. Shuemake seconded the motion, and it carried, with all members voting yes.

Mr. Staggs has a price of \$.30 per foot to fill the cracks in the streets. Mr. Ogle informed the Council that there are probably about 3,000 to 4,000 feet of cracks. Mr. Ogle will see about getting another price for filling the cracks. Mr. Ogle made a motion to fix up to 3,000 feet using the lowest price. Mr. Talbott seconded the motion, and it carried, all members voting yes.

Mr. Staggs thanked Kay and Suzanne for cleaning the office. He got a price of \$1,200 to remove and replace the carpet in the office. Mr. Ogle will get a price from Terry's as well. Mr. Ogle suggested ceramic tile for the entryway. Mr. Talbott made a motion to replace the carpet, and Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion. The motion carried, all members voting yes.

Mr. Staggs has been getting complaints about the flags. The brackets are not holding them. He will ask Mr. Shaffer what Georgetown has done to keep their flags in good shape. Ms. Shuemake will get yellow ribbon for the electric poles. Ms. Haas will help her put the ribbon up.

Ronnie Blair installed the water line at the pump station, and we sent the bill to Ameritcon. The pumps are making a noise, which may be the check valve. Ameritcon does not want to deal with the problem, but it should be under warranty. Mr. Ogle suggested informing Ameritcon that we will go against their bond if they do not take care of it. The Council agreed, and Mr. Staggs will inform Ameritcon. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to buy a 20' or 24' ladder for Mr. Green. Ms. Shuemake seconded the motion, and it carried, with all members voting yes.

Mr. Staggs asked Council for cell phones for him and Mr. Green. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to get 2 cell phones, and Ms. Haas seconded the motion. The motion carried, all members voting yes.

Mr. Staggs will talk to Tony Bishop of T & B Lawn Care about mowing and weed eating the Park. Mr. Ogle made a motion to give Mr. Staggs the authority to hire a helper for Jared for the streets, at the same pay as Jared. Mr. Talbott seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

Mr. Staggs read a letter of resignation from the BPA from Carla Rhodes, due to her moving from the Village. Mr. Ogle made a motion to accept the resignation, and Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion. The motion carried, with all members voting yes.

Mr. Staggs recognized Chief Canter. Ms. Haas asked about the second day of Identakid. Chief Canter told her that the school had cancelled and were supposed to re-schedule. Mr. Staggs asked Chief Canter for a copy of the Police Department schedule. Mr. Staggs asked Council if they wanted to advertise for another Police Officer because we have had 2 break-ins that our officers could not take care of. The Council replied that we can not afford it at this time.

Mr. Staggs recognized Roger Adkins, who came to ask Council to approve the re-plat of part of lots 4 and 5 of the Schneider Subdivision. Mr. Talbott made a motion to approve, and Ms. Shuemaker seconded the motion. The motion carried, all members voting yes.

Mr. Staggs recognized Mr. Ray Canter, who is interested in the one of the vacant BPA positions. Mr. Ogle made a motion to appoint Mr. Canter to a position on the Board of Public Affairs. Mr. Talbott seconded the motion, and it carried, with all members voting yes. Mr. Staggs then swore Mr. Canter in.

Mr. Staggs presented Mr. Duane C. Neu with a plaque from the Village for all of his years in service to this community. The Village really appreciates everything he has done for us.

Captain Ken Ogle and Chief Dennis Schneider of the Hamersville-Clark Township Fire/EMS presented Mr. Neu with a plaque from the Fire Department and EMS in appreciation for his support and friendship over the years. Mr. Neu thanked everyone for their recognition.

Mr. Ogle made a motion to adjourn, and Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion. The motion carried, all voting yes.

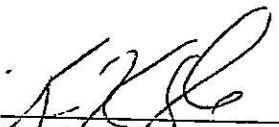

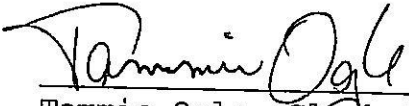
