

ORDINANCE NO. 1988-7

AN ORDINANCE TO REQUIRE MOWING OF PROPERTY
IN THE VILLAGE OF HAMERSVILLE, BROWN COUNTY,
OHIO AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of
Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio, three-fourths or more of all
members elected thereto concurring as follows:

SECTION 1. That the owners of lots, residences, and other
property in the Village of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio, shall
be required to mow their property at least once each month during
the months of May, June, July, August, September and October.

SECTION 2. That the Clerk of the Village of Hamersville
advertise this Ordinance three times in the month of April each
year in the News Democrat.

SECTION 3. That any person violating this Ordinance
shall be fined the sum of ^{Not more than} \$25.00 for the first offense, ^{Not more than} \$50.00
for the second offense and not more than \$100.00 for subsequent
offenses. Failure to mow a lot in any month as required shall
be a separate offense.

SECTION 4. For any person failing to mow a property
more than 2 months, the Village shall give notice of such
failure to mow by certified mail, return receipt requested and
if the property is not mowed within 15 days of the receipt of
the notice, the Village may cause said property to be mowed and
certify the expense thereof to the Auditor of Brown County,
Ohio for collection as other taxes.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance for the public safety of the residents and inhabitants of the Village of Hamersville, Ohio, and it shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
