Regular Village Council Meeting
 October 14, 2013

Present: Mayor Betty Kirkpatrick, Ragan Ernst, Kathleen Miller, John Kirby, Michele Watson, Kim Budke and Fiscal Officer Tammie Ogle.

Also Present: Jared Riley, Vicky Coburn, Skip Bollinger, John Schadle and David Grimes.

Mayor Kirkpatrick called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Kirkpatrick opened the two snow removal bids.

Mr. Kirby made a motion to award the 2013-2014 snow removal contract to That Guy, and Ms. Watson seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

Mayor Kirkpatrick recognized John Schadle from the Brown County Sheriff's Office. He brought a sample contract for Police Protection, and a list of frequently asked questions. Council discussed the possibility of dissolving our Police Department and using the Sheriff's Office.

The Fiscal Officer presented the minutes of the previous meeting to the Council, as well as the Warrant Register, Fund Status, Revenue Status, and Appropriation Status reports, and the September, 2013 Bank Reconciliation. Ms. Watson made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, and Ms. Miller seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes. All other reports and the Bank Reconciliation were read and approved.

Mr. Kirby wants to take a grant writing class, on his own time and at his expense.

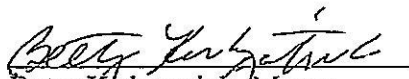

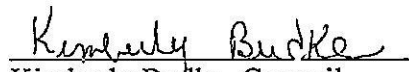
Ms. Watson made a motion to approve the following Appropriation changes. Mr. Kirby seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

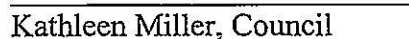

Mr. Kirby made a motion to adjourn, Ms. Miller seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

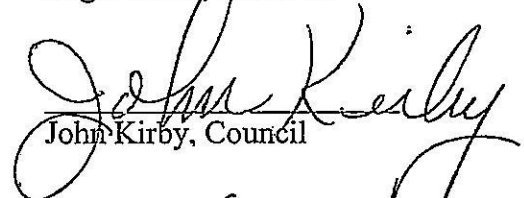
