Regular Village Council Meeting
April 9, 2012

Present: Mayor Keith Staggs, Harry Tolliver, Betty Kirkpatrick, Pat Scott, Michele Watson, John Kirby and Fiscal Officer Tammie Ogle.

Also Present: Chief Canter, Suzanne Madden, Donna Tolliver, Skip Bollinger Charlene Bronner, Dale Owsley, Janet Miller and David Grimes.

Mayor Staggs called this regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then the led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Fiscal Officer presented the minutes of the previous meeting to the Council, as well as the Warrant Register, Revenue Status, Appropriation Status and Fund Status reports, and the March, 2012 Bank Reconciliation. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to accept the minutes, and Mr. Tolliver seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes. All other reports and the Bank Reconciliation were read and approved.

Mayor Staggs recognized Charlene Bronner, who asked about clean-up letters, and who gets them. Council told her that they would go out after the Clean-up days. Chief Canter will give the letters to both the property owners and the tenants. Ms. Bronner brought pictures of some properties she objects to. Chief Canter will notify the property owners and/or tenants verbally, and deliver letters after ten days if the situation has not been taken care of.

Mayor Staggs recognized Dale Owsley, who got a letter from Chief Canter about his dog barking. He told Council that the dog is no longer allowed outside without his wife or himself there. He got a second letter last week, after they stopped letting the dog out. Ms. Miller told Council that she is his neighbor, and she has never heard his dog barking. Chief Canter told him that he has had complaints, and he has heard the dog himself. Council told Mr. Owsley that it sounded like he had taken care of it.

Skip will put two picnic tables next to this building. He will put the flags out before Memorial Day.

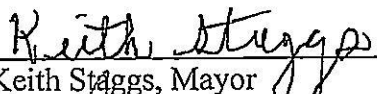
Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to have the emergency siren fixed, and Ms. Scott seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

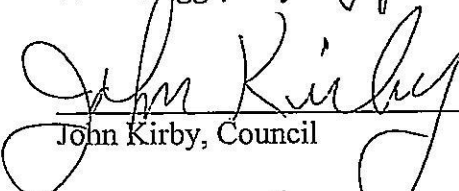
Council discussed people mowing and blowing their grass and leaves into the street.

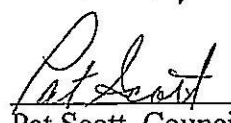

Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to adjourn. Mr. Kirby seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

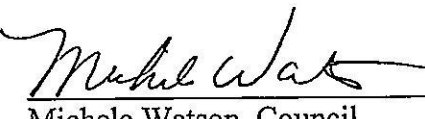

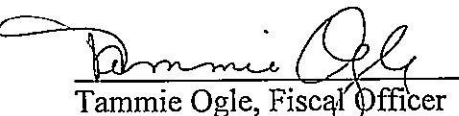
