

AN ORDINANCE FIXING RATES AND CHARGES FOR
WATER SERVICE TO THE VILLAGE OF HAMERSVILLE,
OHIO, ITS INHABITANTS AND OTHER USERS, AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and advisable to establish certain rates and charges for water service to be rendered to the Village of Hamersville and to its inhabitants and other users which will produce sufficient revenues to pay the operating and maintenance expenses of its waterworks system and to provide for the payment of the principal and interest for \$170,000 of First Mortgage Waterworks Revenue Bonds of the village issued for the purpose of paying part of the cost of constructing a waterworks system to serve the village;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio, three-fourths of the members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. Upon completion of construction of the waterworks system and commencement of service to users thereof, the following shall be the rates, payable monthly, charged for the supplying of water services by the waterworks system of the village:

First	1,000 gallons	\$4.50 Minimum
Next	2,000 gallons	1.00 per 1000 gallons
Next	2,000 gallons	0.85 per 1000 gallons
Next	5,000 gallons	0.75 per 1000 gallons
All over	10,000 gallons	0.65 per 1000 gallons

OUTSIDE CORPORATION

All rates and charges, including connection charges, shall be

100 per cent of those for Inside Corporation Limits.

FIRE HYDRANT RENTAL

Per annum, payable semi-annually, minimum charge - \$500.00
(\$50.00 per hydrant)

The fire hydrant rental charge shall be payable from corporate

funds of the village other than proceeds derived from the operation of the waterworks system.

The foregoing charges are minimum charges which cannot be reduced while any of the \$170,000 of First Mortgage Waterworks Revenue Bonds dated June 1, 1983, are outstanding, and are not maximum charges, and the village reserves the right and is obligated to increase the same at any time should the revenues of the waterworks system prove insufficient to pay the operating and maintenance expenses and the debt service, reserve and other security charges of the mortgage revenue bonds issued to pay part of the cost of constructing said waterworks system.

SECTION 2. The bill for any services rendered by the water works system shall be paid within ten (10) days and if not paid within ten (10) days a penalty of ten per cent (10%) shall be added thereto. If the water bill remains unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, such water services shall be cut off and such services shall be resumed only upon payment by the user of an additional fee of \$5.00; and if said bill remains unpaid for a period of forty-five (45) days, it shall be certified over to the County Auditor and collected at the same time and in the same manner as all other taxes, as provided by law.

SECTION 3. The owner of private property which is served by said waterworks system by pipes connected with said system to convey water thereto, shall, as well as the lessee of the premises, be liable to the village for all water from said system used upon said premises.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure in that the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the

inhabitants of the village require the immediate establishment of water rates for financing the construction of the waterworks system for the village, and it shall take effect upon its adoption.
