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REGULAR VILLAGE COUNCIL MEETING
MONDAY AUGUST 10, 1998 7:05 P.M.

Mayor Neu called the meeting to order at 7:05 P.M.

Mayor Neu called for a motion to accept the minutes of the July 1998 meeting as presented.

Mr. Stewart motioned to accept the minutes as presented. Mr. Sowers seconded the motion. Voting: YEA: Stewart, Sowers, Sowers, Staggs. Abstain: Craig.

MOTION CARRIED.

Mayor Neu gave the third reading of ORDINANCE 1998-9 ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING ON VILLAGE STREET BY SEMI - TRACTOR TRAILERS OR OTHER HIGH PROFILE TRUCKS.

Mayor Neu called for a motion to adopt ORDINANCE 1998-9. Mr. Stewart motioned to adopt ORDINANCE 1998-9. Mr. Staggs seconded the motion.

Voting: Stewart: YEA, Staggs: YEA, Craig: YEA, Sowers: YEA, Sowers: YEA.
Opposed: None. **MOTION CARRIED.**(Ordinance 1998-9 will become part of these minutes on the last page.)

Mayor Neu announced that there would be a sewer project progress meeting on Thursday August 13, 1998 at three P.M.

Mr. Staggs questioned what kind of a contract the Board of Public Affairs has with Sherman Rose and Sons. Mr. Staggs received a copy of the contract with Sherman Rose and Sons.

Village ordinance 1998-10 An ORDINANCE ON DISTURBING THE PEACE to be reviewed and discussed at the September 1998 meeting.

The computer for Mayors Court was discussed and Mayor Neu and the police department will check on this and report at the September 1998 meeting.

The village Council was informed of the pending State Highway Proposal. Ms. Craig motioned to authorize the Mayor to voice the villages protest to the proposal.

Mr. Stewart seconded the motion. All voted YEA. Opposed None. **MOTION CARRIED.**

Due to the fact that the lift station for the sewer system was moved after the plans was completed by Brandstetter Carroll (Due to the fact that the property purchase was not complete and the plans was made showing the lift station to be at the site where the village had an option on real estate) Brandstetter Carroll requested that the village pay additional compensation to change the location of the lift station.

Mr. Stewart motioned to have Brandstetter Carroll make the necessary changes at a cost not to exceed two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) Ms. Craig seconded the motion. All voted YEA. Opposed None. **MOTION CARRIED.**

Mayor Neu expressed his appreciation to the police department for their effort in cleaning and painting the mayors court building.

Chief Canter thanked the council for their support in furnishing the necessary materials to refurbish the police building.

Chief Canter also thanked the police officers for donating their time to help with the painting and clean up.

Mr. Staggs reported that a street sign was missing from High Street. Kenny Green will order and replace the missing sign.

Mayor Neu called for a motion to pay the village bills as presented on the voucher.

Ms. Craig motioned to pay the bills as presented. Mr. Stewart seconded the motion. All voted YEA; Opposed None. **MOTION CARRIED.**

Mayor Neu asked if there was any further business to come before the meeting; hearing none Mr. Staggs motioned to adjourn and Ms. Craig seconded the motion.

Mayor Neu adjourned the meeting reminding everyone of the next regular meeting to be held Monday September 14, 1998
