Regular Village Council Meeting
March 11, 2002

Present: Mayor Duane C. Neu, Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle and the following members of the Village Council: Larry Talbott, Donnie Sowers, Betty Kirkpatrick, Diana Shuemaker, Joyce Craig and Wyndal Staggs.

Also Present: County Commissioners Kirby Cornett and Perry Ogden, Cecelia Potts, Kenny Green, Police Chief Jim Canter, Dan Wickerham of the Brown County Solid Waste District, Phil Patton, Pat Scott, Scott Lanter and Art Hunter.

Mayor Neu called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then asked Mr. Cornett to lead the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Neu then recognized the County Commissioners, who came to discuss the early warning sirens. Cinergy has offered to donate and set the poles for the sirens. This siren is a Vortex 4, and covers 6,000 feet. We will put it behind the firehouse. We need a 120v electric line to the pole. It will be tested the third Friday of each month at noon. They would like us to write a letter of appreciation to Cinergy.

Mayor Neu then recognized Dan Wickerham, who came to discuss the solid waste plan for the County. He presented the resolution for the plan. Mayor Neu had the first reading for the Resolution authorizing approval of the revised draft for the Solid Waste District. Mr. Talbott made a motion to adopt, and Ms. Craig seconded the motion. The motion carried, all members voting yes.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes from the previous meeting. Mr. Sowers made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, and Mr. Talbott seconded the motion. The motion carried, all members voting yes.
