

Hamersville Village Council
Regular Session
November 6, 1989; 7:30 p.m.

Mayor Bowyer called the meeting to order.

Present were: Steve Bowyer, Terry Stephens, J.R. Elliott
Pat Hanselman, Jim Walker, Chuck Moore

Also present were: Ken Ginn, Debra Ginn, Jim Canter & Dennie Wooten
Mr. Stratman, Mr. Cardosi and Mr. David Pike were also present.

Minutes were read. Motion by Stephens to approve as read.
Seconded by Elliott, Motion carried.

Mr. Stratman discussed where the village of Hamersville was on the priority list with the EPA grants. It looked as though EPA will not be of any help. We can borrow from FHA for up to 40 years at around 6% interest, though there is a waiting list. Assessments could be as high as 8,000.00 per lot for 30 years thus making 800 per year or 60.00 per mo.

Mayor Bowyer told council that Mr. Purdy had resigned as of December 31, 1989.

Mr. Ginn representing the BPA said the board was concerned with the high cost of Mr. Light, and asked council to interview others for the solicitor position.

Terry Stephens, Pat Hanselman Steve Bowyer were asked to be on the committee to interview lawyers.

Mr. Cardosi and Mr. Pike came to council to ask council to pass a resolution authorizing the mayor to join with other government officials in Brown County in a petition to the Ohio Dept. of Development to form a metropolitan housing authority in Brown County.

Mr. Pike is a landlord working with the MHA now and expressed his support for this resolution.

Motion by Hanselman to approve this resolution, Seconded by Walker. Roll call: Walker-yeah, Stephens-yeah, Moore-No, Hanselman-yeah, Elliott- No. Motion approved.

The post office has requested a 10 minute parking area. Council asked the police department to please monitor.

Ordinance #1989-11 was read for the third time. An ordinance to establish a salary for member of village council, village clerk and mayor. Motion to accept by Elliott seconded by Stephens Motion carried.

Brown County Sheriff dept asked us to accept contract for the housing of prisoners in Brown County jail. Motion to accept

by Hanselman, seconded by Elliott. Motion carried.

Concern was brought to council about the gravel at the end of sisterville road. Dennie to clean up as best he can.

Clerk Ginn asked council to approve the purchase of a typewriter she needs. Motion by Moore to pay 1/3 the cost of the typewriter seconded by Walker, Motion carried.

Motion by Moore seconded by Elliott to buy uniform separates as needed for the officers. Motion carried.

Mr. Canter also asked council to approve the purchase of four tires for the cruiser. Motion to approve purchase by Moore seconded by Walker Motion carried.

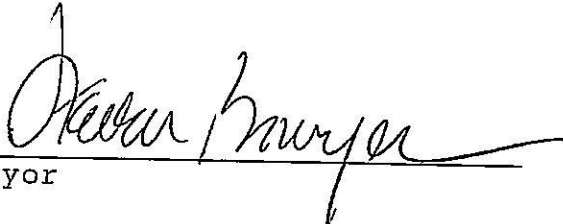
Council was asked to sponser Gary Pitzer at the police academy With the recomendation of the police chief Moore made the motion and Stephens seconded ,Motion carried.
