

RESOLUTION NO. 1989-6

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BROWN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO ESTABLISH BY RESOLUTION AND MAINTAIN A COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT UNDER OHIO REVISED CODE 343.01, Div. (A), THAT CONSISTS OF ALL THE INCORPORATED TERRITORY AND UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY WITHIN THE COUNTY.

WHEREAS, the Brown County Commissioners have determined that there is a need to manage solid waste to protect the environment of Brown County.

WHEREAS, Brown County has a regional solid waste landfill located within the county.

WHEREAS, Amended Substitute House Bill 592 has required counties to form solid waste management districts.

WHEREAS, the Brown County Commissioners have applied for an exemption from the 120,000 population requirement for districts pursuant to ORC Sec. 3734.52(c)(2).

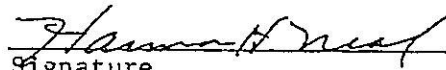
WHEREAS, Ohio EPA has approved Brown Counties exemption to the 120,000 population requirement.

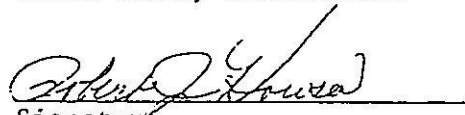

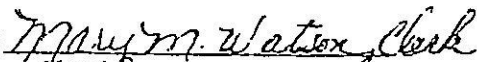
That in the best interest of the residents of Brown County, do hereby form The Brown County Solid Waste Management District, consisting of all incorporated and unincorporated territory in the county.
