

ORDINANCE NO. 1984-1

AN ORDINANCE EMPLOYING AN INTERIM CLERK-TREASURER
FOR THE PERIOD JANUARY 1, 1984 THROUGH MARCH 31, 1984
IN THE VILLAGE OF HAMERSVILLE, BROWN COUNTY, OHIO

WHEREAS, the term of office of the present Clerk-Treasurer
of the Village of Hamersville expires on December 31, 1983, and

WHEREAS, the term of office of the Clerk-Treasurer elect
does not commence until April 1, 1984, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the Village of Hamersville
have a Clerk-Treasurer in order to conduct the orderly affairs of
government,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village
of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) or more of
all members thereof concurring as follows:

SECTION I That RAY ELLIST be, and hereby is,
employed as interim Clerk-Treasurer for the Village of
Hamersville for the period commencing January 1, 1984 and ending
March 31, 1984 at a salary of \$ 275.00, before
payroll deductions.

SECTION II That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency Ordinance necessary for the health, safety and welfare
of the inhabitants of the Village of Hamersville, Brown County,
Ohio and more particularly to insure that the affairs of
government of the Village of Hamersville are conducted in an
orderly manner during the period from January 1, 1984 to March
31, 1984 when the said Village would otherwise be without a Clerk-
Treasurer and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect
immediately upon its passage.
