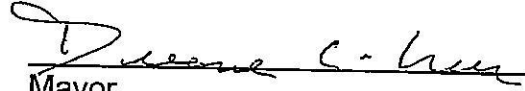
ORDINANCE NO. 1996- 14

**AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING MOTORVEHICLES PASSING ON THE RIGHT
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

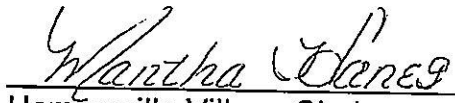
BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio, at least a majority of its members concurring:

1. The driver of a motor vehicle shall not overtake and pass upon the right of another vehicle within an designated intersection or within 200 feet of an designated intersection within the Village of Hamersville.
2. For the purposes of this ordinance the no passing zone of a designated intersection shall be clearly marked with yellow slash marks or diagonal lines placed upon the roadway and a traffic information sign giving notice of the restriction of passing on the right. All markings and signage shall comply with the Ohio Department of Transportation regulations.
3. Any person found guilty of violation of this ordinance shall be fined no more than \$100.00.
4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the reason that it directly affects the health safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Hamersville
