Police Chief Canter informed Council the officers are concerned about whether or not the Council will back them up. Council replied there would be no problem, if the Officer did not provoke the incident.

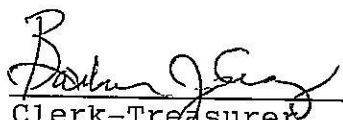
