Motion by Stephens seconded by Hanselman to enter into a depository agreement with first National Bank effective 1-9-88 thru 1-9-90. Motion carried.

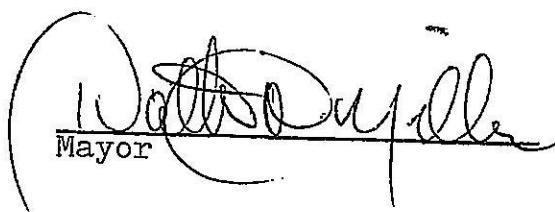
Motion by Moore , seconded by Hanselman to go into executive session. Special invitation given to police Cheif Canter. Motion Carried.

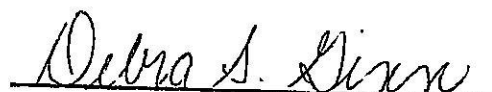
Motion by Stephens Seconded by Hanselman to come out of executive session. Motion carried.
