ORDINANCE NO. 1993-15 SEE NEW ORD. = 2004-06

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING 1988-7 REQUIRING MOWING OF PROPERTY IN
THE VILLAGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hamersville, Brown
County, Ohio, at least a majority of its members concurring:

Section 1. That the owners of lots, residences, and other property in the
Village of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio, shall be required to mow their
property at least once each month during the months of May, June, July, August,
September and October.

Section 2. That the Clerk of the Village of Hamersville advertise this
Ordinance three times in the month of April each year in the News Democrat.

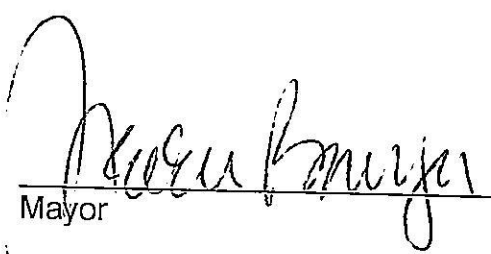
Section 3. Violation of this ordinance shall be classified as a minor
misdemeanor and persons so found in violation shall be fined no more than
\$100.00.

Section 4. For any person failing to mow a property as set forth in Section
1 of this Ordinance; the Village shall give notice of such failure to mow by certified
mail, return receipt requested and if the property is not mowed within 15 days of
the receipt of the notice, the Village may cause said property to be mowed and
certify the expense thereof to the Auditor of Brown County, Ohio for collection as
other taxes.

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency
measure for the reason that it directly affects the health safety and welfare of the
residents of the Village of Hamersville.
