Mayor Abner called the meeting to order.

Minutes were read. Motion by Canter, seconded by Hanes to approve the minutes. Motion carried.

Mr. Ken Robinson gave report on cable. Said village is totally hooked up and they have begun installing.

Mr. Carlton gave on update on McGil-n-Smith progress.

1987-8 was introduced. A resolution declaring it a necessity to construct a sewerage system in the Village of Hamersville and authorizing the application for planning funds from the State of Ohio, Emergency Village Capital Improvement Rotary fund; and declaring it an emergency.

Motion by Hanselman seconded by Hanes to suspend the rules. Motion carried.

Title of Resolution 1987-8 , read three times.

Motion to adopt resolution 1987-8 by Stephens, seconded by Hanes Motion carried.

Resolution 1987-9: Motion by Bowyer seconded by Hanselman to have mayor enter into a contract with McGil -n-Smith. Motion carried.

Discussion on CG&E property. Letter to be sent to CG&E to inform them of our intentions to use the property as a picnic area.

1987-10 A resolution authorizing Debra Ginn , clerk to file an application with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources for the purpose of acquiring funds through the litter prevention and recycling program pursuant to the Ohio Litter Act of 1980 and declaring an emergency.

Moved by Hanes, seconded by Canter. Motion carried.

Bids received from S.O.S. and Rumpke for town garbage collection. Motion to table til December 7, 1987 by Hanes, seconded by Hanselman. Motion carried.

Mr. Wooten requested permission to buy a canopy for the town tractor. Motion to approve purchase by Stephens, seconded by Hanes. Motion Carried.

Chief Canter gave police report. Asked to have Trick of Treat only 1 1/2 hours next year.

Mayor Abner read resignation letter she received from Clerk of Courts, Kathy Hannah.

Motion to accept resignation by Hanselman, seconded by Walker. Motion carried.

Motion by Hanselman to adjourn, seconded by Stephens, Motion carried.
