 Ordinance 1992-10

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE CLERK TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH O'BRIEN ENGINEERING FOR A PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING STUDY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HAMERSVILLE BROWN COUNTY, OHIO, AT LEAST A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1, THAT THE MAYOR AND CLERK ARE HEREBY AUTHORIZED TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH O'BRIEN ENGINEERING FOR A PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING STUDY, A COPY OF SAID CONTRACT BEING ATTACHED HERETO AND MADE A PART OF THIS ORDINANCE.

SECTION 2, THIS ORDINANCE IS DECLARED TO BE AN EMERGENCY FOR THE REASON THAT IT DIRECTLY AFFECTS THE HEALTH, SAFETY, AND WELFARE OF THE RESIDENTS OF THE VILLAGE OF HAMERSVILLE.

Mr. Hanselman said that Mr. Ritchie had contacted him and questioned what the village was going to do about his appeal on the mowing of his lot in the village. Mayor Bowyer said the mowing issue was still an open issue and that the property owners would be notified before the cost of mowing would be certified for taxes.

Council discussed several other issues and requested Mr. Hanselman to get a news item in the News Democrat asking anyone who is interested

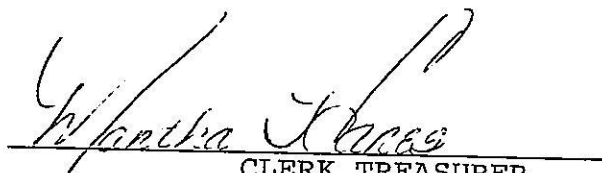
in serving on council to please contact the village or be at the next regular council meeting. There was several names mentioned and all of council is to check around and see if they can locate someone.
