 Duane Neu and Mr. Charles Bunton entered the meeting at 7:30 P.M.

Mayor Bowyer called the meeting to order and asked for a motion to accept the minutes as presented Mr. Johnston motioned to accept the minutes of the March 1, 1993 meeting as presented seconded by Ms. Craig. Voting: Johnston: YEA: Craig: YEA, Dean: YEA: Hanselman: YEA. Voting: NAY: None. **MOTION CARRIED**

Mayor Bowyer then asked for a motion to accept the minutes from the special meeting on March 22, 1993. Mr. Hanselman motioned seconded by Mr. Dean to accept the minutes as presented. Voting: Hanselman: YEA, Dean: YEA, Craig: YEA, Johnston: YEA: Voting: NAY: None. **MOTION CARRIED.**

Mayor Bowyer asked if there was any report on the roof estimates and Mr. Hanselman reported that he had been trying to get in touch with Hanke Improvements. Mr. Hanselman had no other report.

The Clerk reported that she had requested three (3) J.T.P.A. workers for the summer.

Mayor Bowyer said it was time to get the mowing notice in the newspapers however he would have to get in touch with Mr. Leicht and see if he had prepared a new ordinance.

The meeting with F.M.H.A. scheduled for April 15, 1993 was discussed and anyone who wants to attend may do so. The Clerk, and Duane Neu, and Mack Hanes and William Dean Sr. plan to attend along with Mr. O'Brien

Mayor Bowyer called on Mr. Jesse Nester and asked if he wanted to address Council and Mr. Nester replied that he was just a visitor.

Mayor Bowyer recognized Mr. Charles Tucker and Mr. Tucker spoke on the sewer project and suggested that the village divorce themselves from Mr. Worthington; Mayor Bowyer replied that the village was not working with Mr. Worthington. Mr. Tucker said he was in favor of the sewers and would help the council in any way he could.

Mayor Bowyer recognized Mr. Earl and Robert Helton who spoke in favor of the sewers and also asked the village what they could do about the condition of Dooley Alley. The condition of Dooley Alley in very bad. Mayor Bowyer replied that he would speak to the village solicitor and see what could be done about

Dooley Alley since it is a private access alley and would have to be dedicated to the village before major repairs could be made. Mr. Bunton was instructed to make whatever repairs he could at the present time.

Mr. Bunton gave the street report and requested that the village order cold patch. Mr. Hanselman motioned to purchase a load of cold patch from the County Engineer This was seconded by Mr. Neu. Voting: Hanselman: YEA, Neu: YEA, Craig: YEA, Dean: YEA. Voting: NAY: None. **MOTION CARRIED.**

Mr. Neu reported that he had been in contact with Bill Elliott the Clerk from the Village of Bethel and that he had obtained a name of an engineer to call about the sidewalks and curbs. Mr. Neu was instructed to call Bruce Brandsteper from Lexington, Kentucky in regards to the sidewalks and curbs.

Mayor Bowyer asked for a motion to pay the bills as presented. Motioned by Mr. Johnston seconded by Mr. Neu. Voting: Johnston: YEA, Neu: YEA, Craig: YEA, Dean: YEA, Hanselman: YEA. Voting: NAY: None. **MOTION CARRIED.**

Mr. Hanselman motioned that the village pay Martin Rolph \$130.00 (One Hundred and Thirty Dollars) for snow removal. This was seconded by Mr. Johnston. Voting: Hanselman: YEA, Johnston: YEA, Craig: YEA, Dean: YEA, Neu: YEA. Voting: NAY: None. **MOTION CARRIED.**

A motion to go into executive session to discuss personal was made by Mr. Johnston Seconded by Mr. Hanselman. Voting: Johnston: YEA, Hanselman: YEA, Craig: YEA, Dean: YEA, Neu: YEA. Voting: NAY: None. **MOTION CARRIED.**

All visitors left the meeting and the Mayor Clerk and Village Council went into executive session.

A motion to come out of executive session was made by Mr. Neu, seconded By Mr. Dean. Voting: Neu: YEA, Dean: YEA, Craig: YEA, Johnston: YEA, Hanselman: YEA. Voting: NAY: None. **MOTION CARRIED.**

Mr. Johnston motioned seconded By Mr. Hanselman and recommended by Village Council that a Performance Evaluation be required annually of all Village Employees prior to 12/31/ of each year. This evaluation is to be performed by the respective supervisors. This is to begin with the year 1993. All reports to be filed with the village clerk to be filed in each employees files. This is to become a permanent part of all employees records.

Mayor Bowyer and Council instructed the Village Clerk to place an advertisement in the News Democrat and The Brown County Press that the Village will be accepting resumes for fully certified Police Officers until April 26, 1993.

Mayor Bowyer asked if there was any further business to come before the council hearing none Neu motioned Johnston seconded motion to adjourn.
