April 19, 2021

There being no further business, **Motion by: Ms. Miller, Seconded by: Mr. Wilson** to adjourn the meeting. The motion passed unanimously.

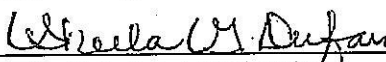
