

ORDINANCE NO. 1990-13

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OR DESTRUCTION OF
PERSONAL PROPERTY IN THE POSSESSION OF THE HAMERSVILLE
POLICE DEPARTMENT, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2923.41 AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Police Department of the Village of Hamersville has in its possession certain personal property which is either unclaimed or confiscated, and

WHEREAS, said agency desires to dispose of said property pursuant to Section 2939.41 of the Ohio Revised Code, now therefore:

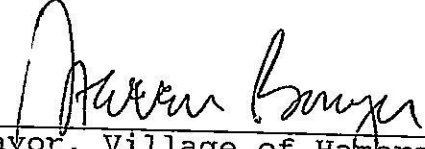
BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio, three-fourths of its members concurring:

SECTION 1. That the Solicitor of the Village of Hamersville, is hereby authorized to petition the Court of Common Pleas, Brown County, Ohio, pursuant to Section 2923.41 of the Ohio Revised Code, for the purpose of obtaining a Court Order for the disposal of said abandoned, unclaimed, or confiscated property.

SECTION 2. That upon obtaining said order from the Court, said Department shall conduct a public auction of all property which may be sold pursuant to Section 2923.41 of the Ohio Revised Code; and shall destroy or otherwise dispose of all remaining property pursuant to said Section.

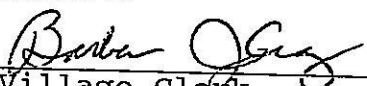
SECTION 3. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure as it directly affects the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Hamersville, Ohio.
