RESOLUTION NO. 1979-2

AUTHORIZING MAYOR TO EXECUTE AND CERTIFY A
PREAPPLICATION FOR FISCAL YEAR 1979 SMALL
CITIES SINGLE PURPOSE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT
FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN
DEVELOPMENT, AND TO SUBMIT THE PREAPPLICATION
FOR OMB A-95 CLEARINGHOUSE REVIEW.

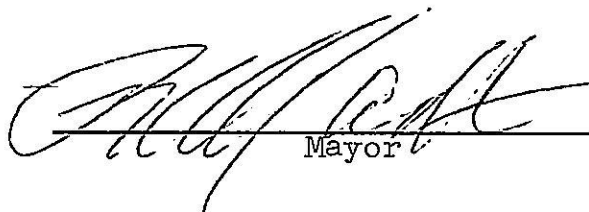
BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hamersville, State of Ohio,
three-fourths (3/4) of all the members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION I. That the Mayor, Roger Adkins, be and hereby is
authorized and directed to execute a preapplication for Fiscal
Year 1979 Small Cities Single Purpose Community Development Funds
to the Department of Housing and Urban Development and to submit
the preapplication for OMB A-95 review.

SECTION II. That the Village of Hamersville hereby certifies
that, pursuant to 24 CFR 570.303 and 570.431, prior to submit-
ting the preapplication has:

- a. Provided citizens with adequate information concerning
the amount of funds available for the proposed community
development and housing activities, the range of acti-
vities that may be undertaken, and other important program
information and requirements.
- b. Informed citizens of the maximum single purpose and com-
prehensive grants for which the applicant may apply,
the criteria for selection of preapplications, and that
the number of preapplications submitted may substantially
exceed the number of applications that may ultimately be
approved from the available funds.
- c. Held at least two public hearings to obtain the views of
citizens on community development needs.
- d. Provided citizens with an adequate opportunity to arti-
culate needs, express preferences about proposed activities
assist in the selection of priorities, and otherwise to
participate in the development of the preapplication.
- e. Provided citizens with an adequate opportunity to arti-
culate needs and express preferences with respect to the
Citizen Participation Plan.
- f. Informed citizens of the processes to be followed in
soliciting and responding to the views and proposals of
citizens in a timely manner.
