Regular Meeting
Hamersville Board of Public Affairs
Monday January 15, 1996 7:10 P.M.

Present: William Dean Sr., Edward Martin Jr., Mack Hanes, Mayor
Steven Bowyer, Clerk Treasurer Martha Hanes.
Also present Ms. Kay Elliott, Mr. Lynn Dunn, Mr. Colby Saylor.

President Mack Hanes called the meeting to order and asked
Mayor Steven Bowyer to swear in Mr. William Dean Sr. as a
member of the Board.

Mayor Bowyer swore in Mr. William Dean Sr. to a full term on the
Board of Public Affairs.

Mr. Hanes asked for a motion to accept the minutes of the previous
meeting as presented.

Mr. Dean motioned and Mr. Martin seconded the motion to approve
the minutes. All voted YEA: **MOTION CARRIED.**

Mr. Hanes asked for a motion to pay the bills as presented. Mr.
Dean motioned and Mr. Martin seconded the motion to pay the bills
as presented. All voted YEA: **MOTION CARRIED.**

Mr. Hanes asked for a report from Lynn Dunn on the Electric
Department. Mr. Dunn reported that all of the electric is in good
shape and he would like to be allowed to order some supplies that
he feels he will need when C.G. & C Co. turns the other portion of
the line over to the village.

Mr. Dunn stated that he needed to order some transformers and
other small supplies. Mr. Dean motioned and Mr. Martin seconded
the motion to allow Mr. Dunn to purchase the supplies.

All voted YEA: **MOTION CARRIED**

Mr. Hanes brought up the subject of presenting Dennie Schneider
and the Hamersville Clark Township Fire Department with some
plaques for all the things they have done for the Board. Mr. Martin
motioned and Mr. Dean seconded the motion to purchase the

plaques. The clerk instructed to order the two (2) plaques one for Dennie Schneider and the other for the Hamersville and Clark Township Fire Department. All voted YEA: **MOTION CARRIED.** This was the first meeting of the new year and the following was elected to serve the Board. President: Mack Hanes, Vice President Edward Martin Jr.

Mr. Saylor reported on the Water Department. Mr. Saylor said he had to kick the pumps up due to the water pressure.

It was reported to Mr. Dunn that there was a light out on Dooley Alley and there is also a light out by the Hamersville Food Mart. Mr. Martin questioned if the Board should dig the fire hydrant out if there is another big snow; and Mr. Saylor said he would dig them out if it snowed another big snow.

Mr. Hanes asked for a report from Ms. Elliott on the outstanding utility bills.

Ms. Elliott reported that since this was an early meeting the last day for payment would not be until the 16th. due to the holiday.

Mayor Bowyer up dated the board on the sewer project. Mayor Bowyer asked the Board if Mr. Dunn could move the switch on the lights in the police building. The police fund will pay for the materials and Mr. Dunns labor. Mr. Dunn will complete this A.S.A.P.

The Clerk was instructed to write a letter to John Layman in regards to have the wiring in his house on North Avenue completed and inspected.

Mr. Dunn reported that he had found the village gas tank unlocked and suggested that all employees be told to keep the gas tank locked at all times.

Mayor Bowyer said he would pass this on to the proper employees. Mr. Dunn reported that he had checked out the salt spreader that Mr. Martin had heard advertised and had found that the spreader had parts missing.

There was no report from C.G. & E. Co. on the line they are going to sell the village.

Mr. Dean questioned if the work at MAP INDUSTRIES was completed and Mr. Dunn said it was almost completed. There is just a few minor things to be completed and it should be wrapped up very soon.

Mr. Hanes asked if there was any other business to come before the board; hearing none Mr. Dean motioned to adjourn seconded by Mr. Martin. All voted YEA: MOTION CARRIED
Mr. Hanes adjourned the meeting reminding everyone that the next meeting will February 19, 1996 at 7:00 P.M.
