**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE
OF INSURANCE FOR THE VILLAGE OF
HAMERSVILLE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

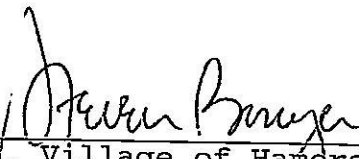
BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio, at least two-thirds of its member concurring:

SECTION 1. That the Village Clerk is hereby authorized to pay the John Woods Insurance Agency the sum of \$4,268.00 for general liability insurance for the Village of Hamersville.

SECTION 2. That the Clerk shall charge the following accounts for said insurance, to the Board of Public Affairs, the sum of \$2,297.00; to the General Fund the sum of \$1,971.00.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure for the reason that it is necessary to insure Village operations to preserve the general health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Hamersville.
