RESOLUTION NO. 1980-4

DESIGNATING A GOAL FOR AWARDING CONTRACTS TO MINORITY
BUSINESSES IN FISCAL YEAR 1980 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT
PROGRAM.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) or more of all the members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION I. Definitions. That as used in this resolution, the following terms shall have these meanings:

- a). Minority Group Members means citizens of the United States who are Negroes, Spanish speaking persons, Orientals, American Indians, Eskimos and Aleuts.
- b). Minority Business means businesses which are owned at least fifty (50) percent by Minority Group Members as defined in this Section or publicly owned businesses at least fifty-one (51) percent of the stock of which is owned by Minority Group Members.

SECTION II. That affirmative efforts will be made to award five to ten (5-10) percent of contracts in the Fiscal Year 1980 Community Development Program of the Village of Hamersville to Minority Businesses. Said percentage is based on dollar value of contracts awarded.
