

RESOLUTION #1997 - 20

RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO
APPROPRIATE EASEMENT AND
PASSED AS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE

WHEREAS, the Village of Hamersville has initiated a waste water collection project; and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary to obtain easements to lay the transmission lines of said waste water treatment system in the Village of Hamersville; and,

WHEREAS, the village has made efforts to have easements signed by the appropriate landowners; and,

WHEREAS, some landowners have refused or failed to sign.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT:

Section 1: The Council of the Village of Hamersville considers it necessary and declares its intention to appropriate for sewer purposes an easement in and to the premises as described in the attached exhibit.

Section 2: The Mayor is authorized to cause written notice of the passage of this resolution to be given to the owners and persons in possession or having an interest of record in the premises. This notice shall be served and returned according to law.

Section 3: This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure as a result of the progression of the sewer collection system and financing of the same the village must know that they can enter onto the properties to install the transmission lines and for the reason that the public health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Hamersville, Ohio, require the immediate issuance of said resolution and the same shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption.
