Motion by Moore to approve ordinance Seconded by Hanes Motion carried.

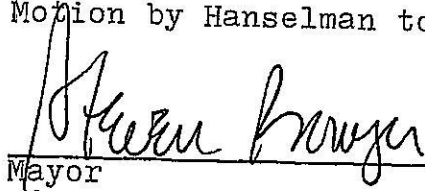
Police Canter gave his report.

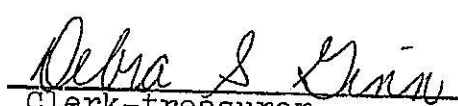
Motion by Moore to allow the police department to purchase ammo for qualification. Seconded by Bowyer Motion carried.
