

AN ORDINANCE TO INCREASE THE WATER RATES
CHARGED TO WATER CUSTOMERS OF THE VILLAGE
OF HAMERSVILLE, OHIO

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hamersville, Ohio, three-fourths or more of all members elected thereto concurring, as follows:

SECTION 1. WHEREAS, the cost of acquiring and distributing potable water in the Village of Hamersville has increased due to the increased charges to the Village by its supplier, Village of Georgetown, and, WHEREAS, it is necessary to increase the water rate and charges to the customer of the Village of Hamersville, Ohio, in order to maintain the water fund in a solvent condition, and

WHEREAS, the Council and Board of Public Affairs has studied the situation and the Board of Public Affairs recommends the following rate be adopted, NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hamersville, Ohio, that,

SECTION 2. The following water rates and charges also commonly known as a rate schedule shall apply beginning with all water sold on and after April 15, 1981, to water customers of the Village of Hamersville, Ohio.

Up to 2,000 gallons	940 9.40 (Minimum)
Next 1,000 gallons or fraction thereof	1125 1.55
Next 2,000 gallons or fraction thereof	1270 1.45 per 1,000 gal.
Next 5,000 gallons or fraction thereof	1.35 per 1,000 gal.
All over 10,000 gallons	1.20 per 1,000 gal.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance in that it is necessary for the public health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Hamersville, Ohio and more particularly

so that adequate water rates and charges can be made so as to maintain the water fund of said village in a solvent condition and so that safe drinking water and adequate fire protection can be provided and this Ordinance shall be in immediate effect upon its passage.
