Regular Village Council Meeting
 June 13, 2016

Present: Mayor Betty Kirkpatrick, Kim Budke, Kathleen Miller and Fiscal Officer Tammie Ogle.

Mayor Kirkpatrick called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Kirkpatrick introduced Wayne Hill and Dale Owsley, new Council Members. The Mayor swore them in.

The Fiscal Officer presented the minutes of the previous meeting to the Council, as well as the Warrant Register, Fund Status, Revenue Status and Appropriation Status reports, and the May, 2016 Bank Reconciliation. Ms. Miller made a motion to pay all bills. Ms. Budke seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

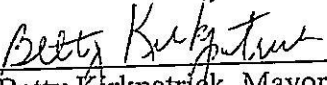
Ms. Budke asked for suggestions for the float for the Brown County Fair parade.

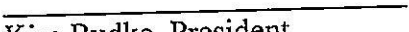
Jason is working on the curbs.

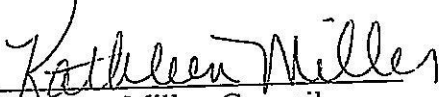
Ms. Budke made a motion to adjourn, and Ms. Miller seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

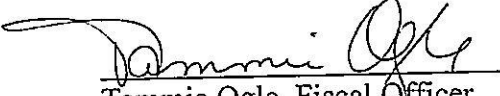
