RESOLUTION NO. 1996-06

RESOLUTION FOR ELECTION ON TAX LEVY EXCEEDING TEN-MILL LIMITATION

The Council of the Village of Hamersville, Ohio, met in regular session on July 1, 1996 with the following members present:

Wyndal Staggs - PRESENT
William Dean, SR - ABSENT

Council person CRAIG moved the adoption of the following resolution:

RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Hamersville, Ohio, two-thirds of all the members concurring:

1. The amount of taxes that may be raised within the ten-mill limitation will be insufficient to provide for the necessary requirements of the Village of Hamersville, and it is necessary to levy a tax exceeding that limitation for

the purpose of providing and maintaining motor vehicles, communications, and other equipment, or the payment of salaries of permanent police personnel, including the payment of the policemen employer's contribution required under section 742.33 of the Revised Code, all pursuant to O.R.C. 5705.19(j)

2. The proposed levy will be an additional tax outside of the ten-mill limitation. The levy will constitute a tax of one mill for each dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$.01 for each \$100 of valuation.

2. The proposed levy is a renewal of an existing levy of one mill outside of the ten-mill limitation, approved by the voters on November 5, 1991. The renewal levy will constitute a tax of one mill mills for each dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.01 for each \$100 of valuation.

3. The levy shall remain in effect for five years for the years 1996, 1997, 1998, 1999, and 2000.

4. The levy shall be placed on the tax list of the current year after the February settlement next succeeding the election, if the electors voting on it approve the levy as provided by law.

5. The Clerk of the Village of Hamersville, shall certify a copy of this resolution to the Board of Elections of Brown County not later August 15, 1996 *for Nov 5 1996 Election* and request the Board to provide for notice of the election as required by law.
