Regular Village Council Meeting
November 10, 2014

Ms. Ernst made a motion to approve the following Appropriation changes:

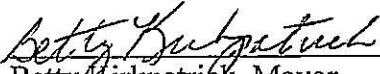

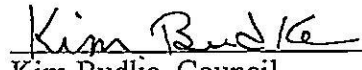
Ms. Miller seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

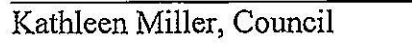
Chief Sutton informed Council that the Police Department will participate in Shop with a Cop this year. He will try to get some donations.

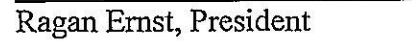
Ms. Ernst made a motion to adjourn. Ms. Budke seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

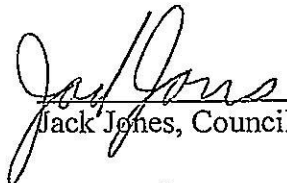

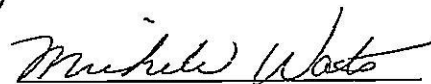
